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	<p>Delegated Regulation (UE) 2020/688 on movements of animals within the EU - In force (will enter into application on 21 April 2021) Definition of the rules concerning transport, requirements for slaughterhouses receiving transported animals, requirements related to the health certificate and notification of movements between Member States.</p> <p>Possible derogations from the health certificate; possible extension of the duration of validity of the health certificate (from 10 to 30 days).</p> <p>Delegated Regulation (UE) 2020/686 on movements of germinal products - In force (will enter into application on 21 April 2021) Definition of the obligations of registered and approved establishments, obligations related to movements of germinal products, information to be provided to the competent authority and information related to the animal health certificate.</p> <p>No significant changes.</p> <p>Implementing Regulation (UE) 2018/1882 on the application of certain disease prevention and control rules - In force (will enter into application on 21 April 2021) The prevention and control rules of certain animal diseases, as defined in article 9 of the regulation 2016/429, shall apply to the categories of listed diseases for the listed species and groups of listed species referred to in the Annex to this Regulation.</p> <p>Implementing Regulation on identification and registration of horses – Upcoming, no available draft It should define the format and the content of the SLID and the deadlines for the identification of horses.</p> <p>Implementing Regulation on movements of germinal products (2018/7072) – Draft Definition of the rules concerning information needed for the approval of an establishment, deadlines to communicate these information, technical requirements for the marking of germinal products and operational requirements for traceability, information to be indicated on consignments of germinal products and notification of movements.</p> <p>No significant changes.</p> <p>Implementing Regulation related to the model forms of health certificates for movements of germinal products - Upcoming, no available draft</p>
