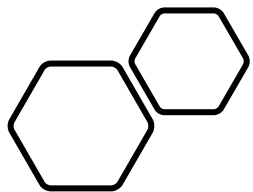

Big Changes

- Changes – FTA/no FTA
- Leaving EU single market & customs union
- UK will be a “Third Country” to the EU
- Movements processes more complex
- More time to prepare – all steps will take longer
- Appoint a shipper to help you
- Try not to move horses in January

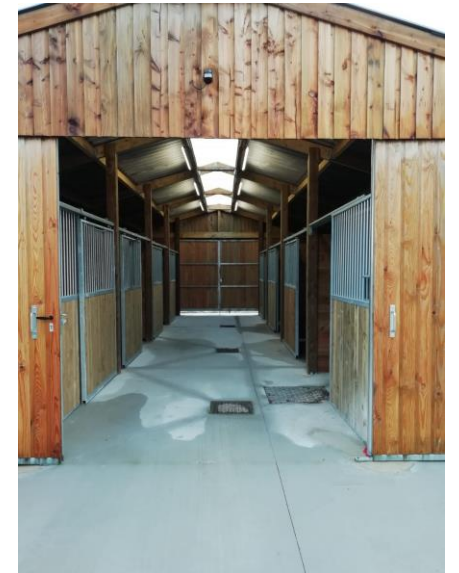
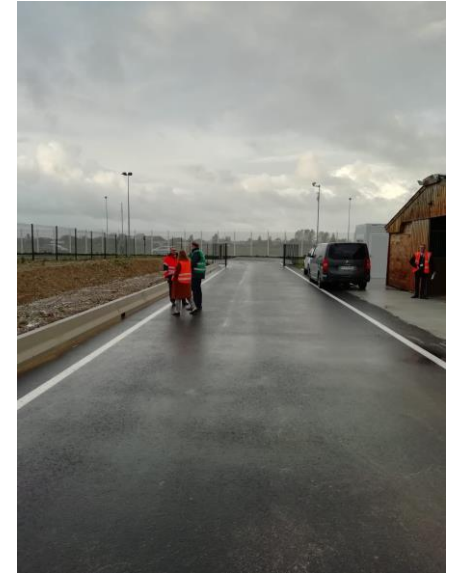

Border Control Posts (BCP)



BCPs

- Documentary, ID and physical health checks
- Must have EHC for transit countries in English & language of destination country
- Horses to be unloaded (Images: BCP Coquelles)
- Limited processing capacity at BCPs = delays
- Limited opening hours
