Top Tips

- If intending to submit a response and haven't done so yet:
 - On the home page for the online questionnaire, there is a PDF of the consultation document. This explains the context behind each question. If unsure what a question means, or what an acronym stands for, check the PDF.
 - Note duplication of a question on the online questionnaire (q8 and 9 / q10 and 11).
 - Explaining your answers in the free text box is incredibly helpful for our analysis.
 - The consultation is long, but we are covering a broad range of subjects linked to equine ID and traceability to ensure a complete picture and to cover the range of interests across the equine sector.
 - The questions are worded as they are in order to mitigate bias in answers.

Next Steps

- Now to Tuesday 28th June : await final responses
- Wednesday 29th June onwards: analysis of results, qualitative and quantitative
- By end of September 2022 : publish consultation results and government response report
- In parallel, start to implement reform:
 - Publishing new guidance for industry
 - Establishing areas requiring legislative change to the Equine Identification Regulations (England) 2018
- Further engagement with our key stakeholders i.e. BHC, OVs, semi-wild forum, PIOs, transporters throughout the process
