NEWC survey: equine welfare establishments



• Aim:

- To establish current total capacity of the UK sector
- To ascertain what impact the cost of living crisis has had to-date and main areas of concern looking forward

Objectives:

- To help inform advice & guidance from NEWC
- To understand resilience of the sector, particularly if we start to see a rise in rehoming requests and welfare cases
- To identify what support might be needed
- Survey will launch by end of December & run for a month

















NEWC survey: equine keepers



• Aim:

 To explore what impact the cost of living crisis has had todate across the UK

Objectives:

- Provide insight into how equine keepers are experiencing the economic crisis and identify their immediate concerns this winter
- Understand which strategies keepers are using to mitigate the impact of the economic crisis
- Enable NEWC to provide targeted advice and guidance to support keepers
- Survey will launch by end of December



















England

- BHC responded to the LAIA post implementation review surveys highlighting:
 - While changes to the legislation are needed, the main concern is with the implementation
 - Negative impact to businesses due to inconsistent costs & implementation across Local Authorities
 - Need for appropriate training for inspectors (government approved syllabus)

Scotland

- BHS Scotland organised a visit to livery yards for Scottish government officials in August
- Stressed the need for a considered and phased approach to licensing, starting with registration of premises















Enforcement



- APGAW published its report: *Improving the Effectiveness of Animal Welfare Enforcement* in August
- The report calls for:
 - All English councils to use dedicated animal welfare officers – potential regional approach
 - The UK Government to help to facilitate better collaboration between agencies working on the ground
- Next steps: Parliamentary roundtable to discuss the findings of the report
