




Equestrian Digest Campaign to safeguard sector's future




















Project 2026

The UK Government has broken its commitment to abolish the 2026 deadline for saving vital off-road routes.

For horse riders, who currently have access to just 22% of the rights of way network, this decision will be particularly damaging.

In 2022 alone, 69 horses were killed on Britain's roads and 139 riders injured.
